Our Multiplication Tables Check results are lower than we would aspire to, although these outcomes do represent significant progress across the year, a large amount of input from the staff and hard work from the children. But in order to improve these in 2023-24, we have taken on a new times table programme recommended by the Mobius Maths Hub. All staff have been trained on how to implement this in the classroom, and Summer Class have been trialling it this term in preparation. We have been impressed with what we have seen so far, and therefore will also be using it in Autumn Class next year to cement the times table knowledge of our Y5 and Y6 pupils.
